





Poon Lim was awarded the British Empire Medal in recognition of his courage.
 - 2. In 1995, Canada issued four stamps commemorating the World Road Congress being held in the same year in Montreal, Canada. The stamps depict bridges in a variety of designs, built in various parts of Canada during different period. Photography and computer illustration were used to design the four stamps. The background shows a scenic view of the bridge as it merges into more technical drawings in the foreground.

The first stamp features Heartland Bridge of New Brunswick situated across the St. John River. It was built in 1901 using wood rather than steel on the uncovered bridge for keeping the costs down.
