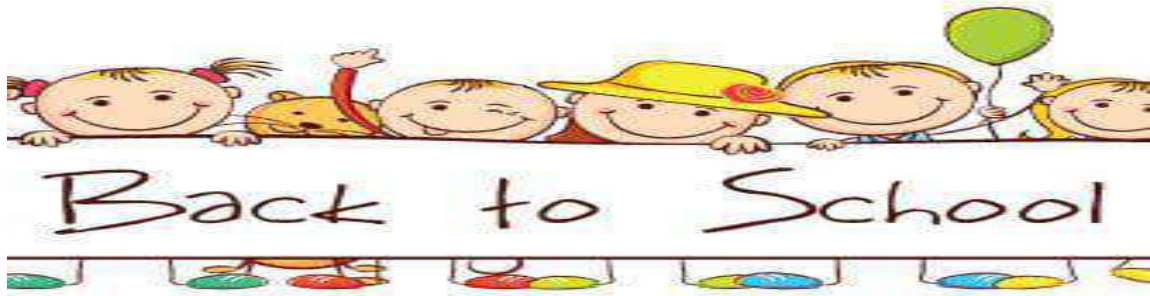

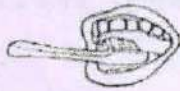
Note:

The judgement criteria will be - content, presentation, fluency confidence.



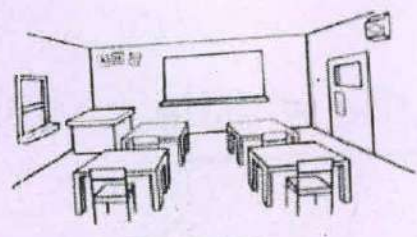

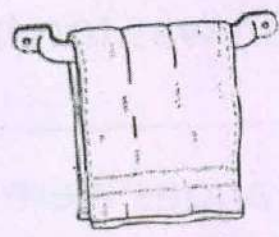
