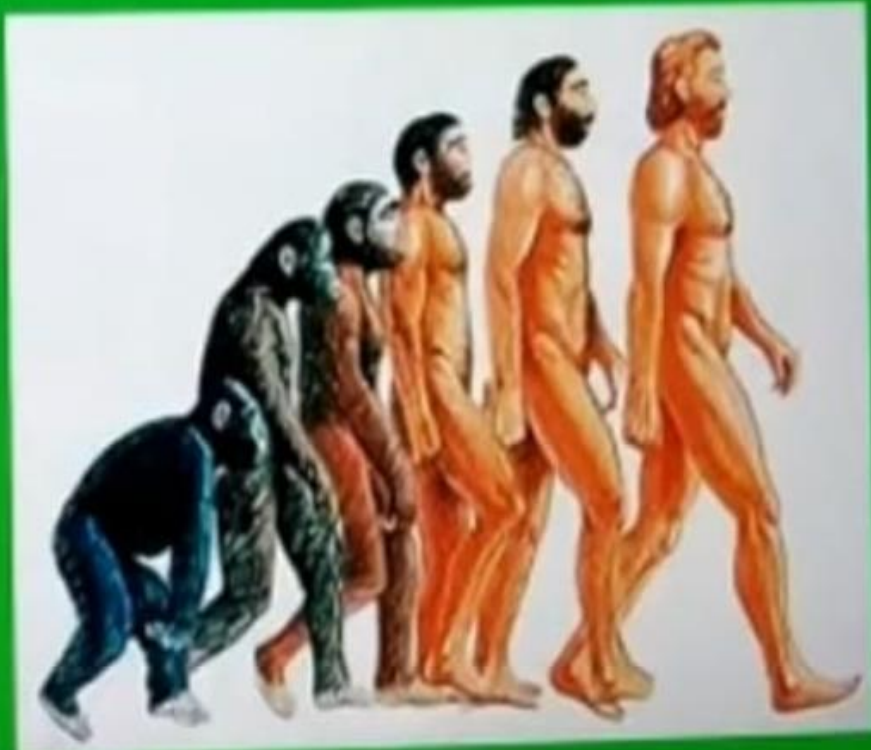

MAN STARTED THINKING OF KILLING WILD ANIMALS BUT HOW?

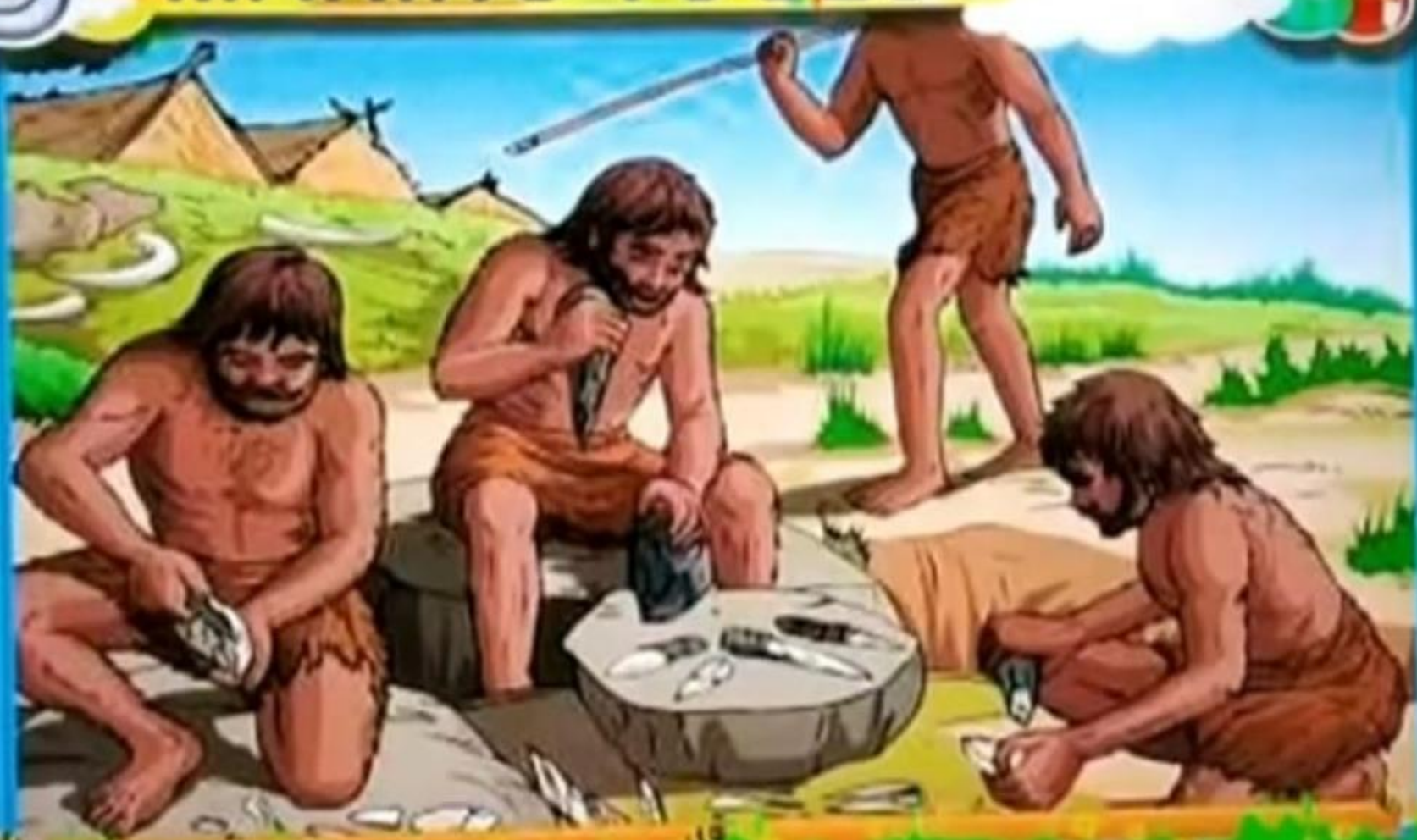
HE NOW FELT THE NEED

TO KILL ANIMALS.

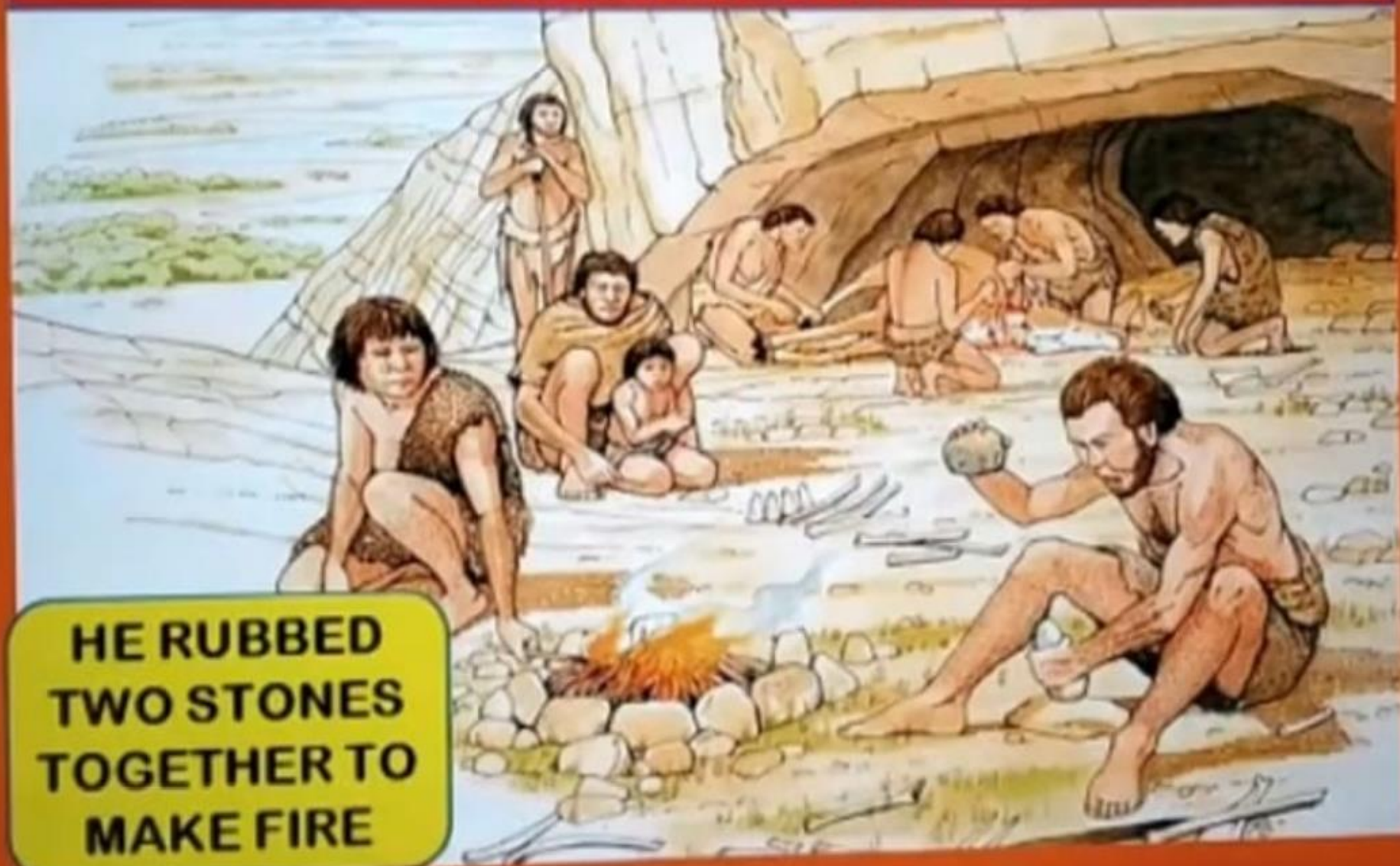


MAN USED THESE FOR DIGGING ROOTS
