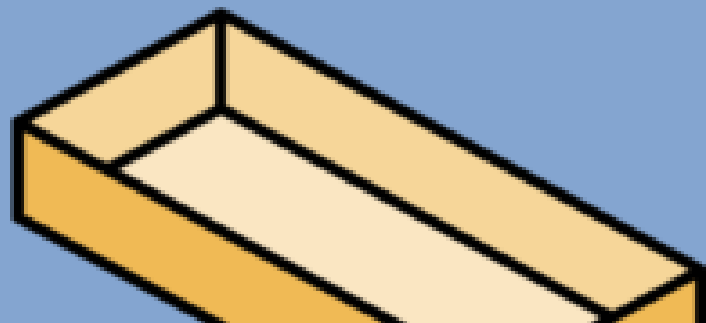


What's the Capacity?

a container can hold.



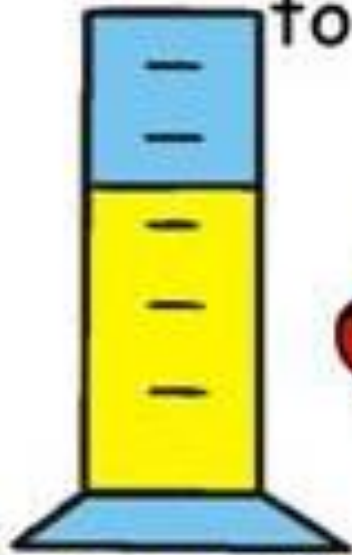
